How Milwaukee Brewers Got a New & Improved Place to Practice

Natina was part of the American Family Fields of Phoenix renovation project, which the Milwaukee Brewers call home during spring training. Natina was applied to chain-link fences for a rustic brown finish and their affiliate company, West Coast Turf, supplied new natural turfgrass sod and sprigs to the stadium.

Natina was recommended as an alternative to paint or vinyl coating. Since the fence is a major focal point, it was important to have a natural patina that blended well with the stadium backdrop
